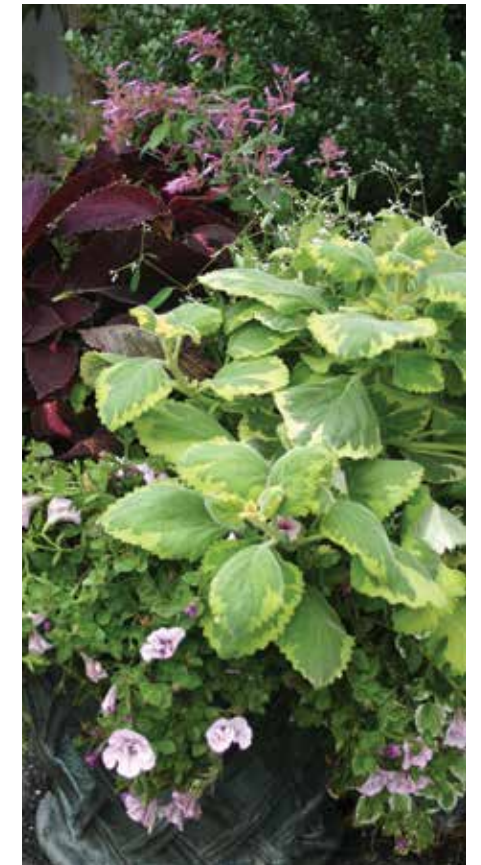

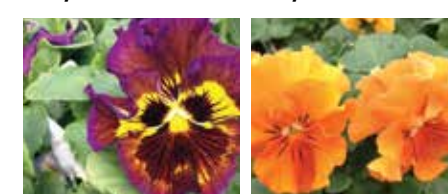

Early Spring Selections

Arctotis (African Daisy) (*syn. Venidium*) (1 qt)

South African daisies, solitary and elegant, rise 12" above a basal rosette of grey foliage. Cascades 12" over the edge of a pot or spreads along the edge of the flower bed. Performs well in heat, thrives in a wide range of soils, salt tolerant. Cold has little effect, produces until the deep frost. Simply superb in every respect. Flowers close up in the early evening.

Pink form with a light center and more compact growth.

Argyranthemum frutescens (Marguerite Daisy) (1 qt)

Heat tolerant, yellow blooms. 14-18"

A. f. Sassy Pink

Pink flowers, accentuated by a yellow center that are early to bloom. 12-18"

A. f. Vera

Fine blue foliage with white blooms. 18"

Artemisia stelleriana Silver Bullet (1 qt)

Mounding, silvery white, dissected foliage. Vigorous plant is drought, heat and cold tolerant and requires very little maintenance. Spread 10-20".

Centaurea gymnocarpa (1 qt)

Felt like leaves with lacerated edges. Grey almost white. It stands completely upright to about 24".

Dusty Miller Cirrus (1 qt)

A bolder-looking plant, less finely cut leaves than other varieties. Growing only 6 to 8 inches tall, it fills out beds and containers and can be used as a ground cover. Known for its excellent weather resistance. Cirrus has distinctive woolly, grey-white foliage with scalloped edges that makes it an effective contrast plant.

Foeniculum v. dulce Rubrum (Bronze Fennel) (1 qt)

The lacy deep bronze foliage of this herb is punctuated by its yellow umbel flower heads. It is stately growing to 4-5' and forms a beautiful contrast with other flowers or herbs.

Linaria maroccana Fantasista (1 qt)

With mini snapdragon flowers — a recently found top favourite. An almost instant nectar bar for pollinators.

Nemesia fruticans Karoo (1 qt)

Large fragrant flowers, grows to 12-14".

N. f. Karoo Dark Blue

Medium blue flowers.

Pink flowers with a yellow center.

N. f. Karoo White

White flowers.

Nemesia hybrids Opal Innocence (1 qt)

Vigorous, upright growth and heat tolerant. 6-12" Shades of rosy-pink, ivory & lavender flowers.

Osteospermum Hybrids (Cape Daisy) (1 qt)

Daisy like flowers. Vegetatively produced varieties have superior heat tolerance. Blooming slows in summer, but flushes with a fall floral display.

O. x Voltage Yellow

Earliest to bloom. Clear bright yellow flowers. 10-12"

O. x Voltage White

Earliest to bloom. Clear white flowers with a yellow center. 10-12"

Pansies (1 qt)

The quintessential spring flower! Large blooms. 12-18"

P. Delta Bolero Mix

Double, fringed blooms deep to light colors, all generously marked with everything from merry faces to subtle shading.

P. Delta Cool Water Mix

Shades of violet-blue, purple & white.

P. Delta Lavender Blue Shades

Light lavender with deep blue blotch and yellow eye.

Double fringed blooms, pastel flower mix.

P. Fizzy Lemonberry

Double fringed blooms, pale yellow & pink.

P. Frizzle Sizzle Mix

Great bold color variation in this fringed mix.

P. Frizzle Sizzle Orange

Bright clear orange with fringed double blooms.

P. Freefall Cream

White with creamy-yellow centers.

P. Karma Butterfly

Unusual color combination reminiscent of a tropical butterfly with neon blue wings. Blue with a yellow splash in the center.

P. Ultima Morpho

Blue wing with yellow and gold flowers. Very compact, 6" height and spread.

P. WonderFall Blue Picotee Shades

White and shades of blue-violet borders.

P. x Cool Wave Blueberry Swirls

Spreading, primrose with whiskers, blue purple edge.

P. x Cool Wave Raspberry

Shades of rosy-purple with white around flower centers.

P. x Cool Wave Yellow

Spreading, pure bright yellow.

Pericallis hybrid Senetti (1 qt)

Mounding, and will be covered with daisy-like flowers when in full bloom. 10-12"

Bicolor petals, hot pink outer petals with white inner petals.

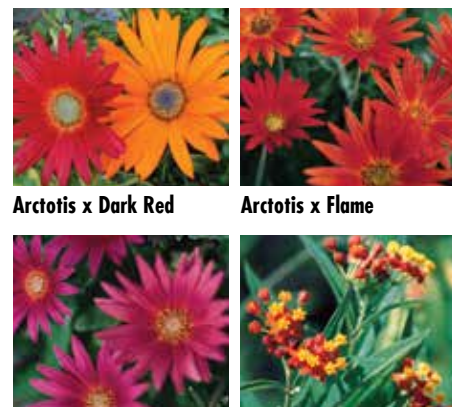

Abelmoschus manihot (1 qt)

Elegant, 5" soft lemon flowers with yellow petals surrounding a throat of deep purple. Large palmate spiny leaves and long seed pods resemble that of okra, a close relative. Blooms late July into fall. 5-6'

Abutilon pictum Thompsonii

Flowering maple variety, yellow and cream variegation on green leaves. Orange bell shaped flowers. 3-4'

Acalypha wilkesiana Copperleaf Plant (1 qt)

Colorful splotched leaves, molted in red, copper and pink. Large showy leaves, grown for its beautiful and unusual foliage. Upright growth habit, looks great in a shade garden or a container. 2'

Agastache a. Apricot Sprite (1 qt)

Ornamental favorite, these Agastache are unlike those commonly sold as the coarse herb. Leaves and flowers of this fragrant, fruit scented genera are used for teas and potpourri, fresh or dried. 15"

Alternanthera (1 qt)

A. dentata Rubiginosa
Deep purple, glossy ovate leaves are produced along sprawling, vigorous stems. In a container, it reaches throughout the pot rather than tidily spilling over one edge. Easy to grow, maintenance free tropical. 12-24"

A. ficoidea Red Threads
Deep rose burgundy, this variety is a compact edger with finely cut leaves. 8"

Anagallis Wildcat (1 qt)

Beautiful, thickly mounding foliage with tiny leaves creates a textured appearance at the garden's edge. Many small flowers appear continuously. 8"

Vivid true blue flower with yellow stamens.

Bright orange petal with small blue eye.

Angelica (Giant Wild Parsnip) (1 qt)

This choice biennial is architecturally bold and dramatic when it blooms the second season after purchase. The foliage is palmate and sizable above which stout deep-purple stems rise. The period of interest is varied and long, starting with a bulbous leaf sheath. Deep purplish-red flowers amass in 6" terminal umbels that open gradually over a period of weeks. Spread of 3', 5-6' tall.

Arctotis hybrid (African Daisy) (1 qt)

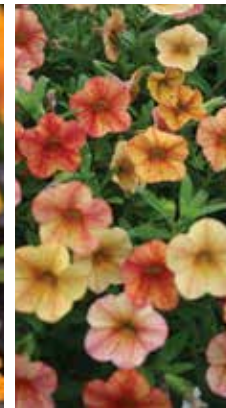

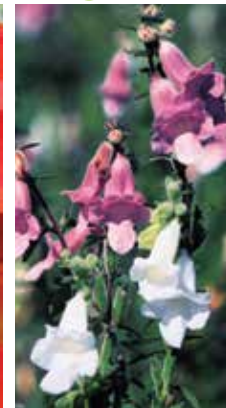

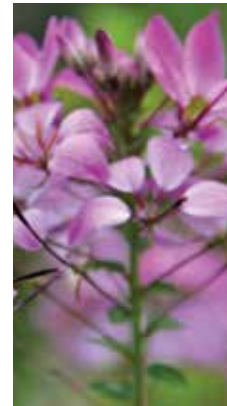

(Swan River Daisy) (1 qt)

Fine, compact selection of medium blue. Profusion of tiny daisies are produced over finely cut sprawling foliage. Charming in pots, the rock wall, or as an edging plant. Likes good drainage. 6"

Browallia americana (1 qt)

Uncommon, vigorous species. Fine, stiff 12-15" stems are covered in star-shaped blossoms. Lush foliage, free flowering, openly branched habit, little care.

Large medium flowers bloom profusely throughout the season. 12-14"

Large colorful flowers with great heat tolerance. Fully double flower, less seed set and fewer seedlings.

Calibrachoa (1 qt)

Petunia like, they look like tiny petunias, but they are actually an entirely different species. Compact, mounded plants on trailing stems. Prolific bloomers that produce 1" wide flowers from spring to frost. 8-12" spread.

Shimmering soft, silvery foliage. Resilient to seashore conditions and drought tolerant once well-established. 12-24"

Canna hybrids (2 gallon)

Their bold leaves convey drama to any border. The shorter selections impart bulk to the center of containers. Grow with ample moisture to achieve greatest height in the ground.

Cardiospermum halicacabum
(Love-In-A-Puff) (8" pot on bamboo stake)

A garden favorite vine. Three seeds contained in a green papery, globe-shaped, balloon puff are each marked with a dark heart shape. Decorative and wondrous, these plants delight all ages. Fun, very delicate and robust tendrils cling vivaciously up to 10'.

☀️ Here lies a vast selection of primarily tender perennials in Zone 7 that behave like annuals. They grow quickly, bloom for a considerable length of the season lasting until hard frost. The characteristic structure of the flower consists of the corolla or tubular part of the flower consisting of two lips of unequal length, lower one usually spreading. The calyx or covering is often quite distinctive, having two-lips. Salvias are an important source of nectar for hummingbirds and butterflies. They are a decorative necessity for a border in need of color in August through early November. Quite simply, they are essential.

Perennial Selections

Ajuga reptans Catlin's Giant (1 qt) Zone 4

This is one of the most indispensable ground covers around. It forms a 6-inch-tall mat of glossy leaves that always seem to look neat and fresh without being too vigorous. Individual plants grow as a rosette and they intertwine to form a solid carpet that withstands some foot traffic. In the spring, it sends up 4-6" tall flower stalks with many blue purple flowers on them. Ajuga is great in rock gardens, in the front of beds and borders, under leggy shrubs or small trees, along paths, anywhere you want to cover the ground with attractive foliage and little flowers. Dark, full, foliage, blue flowers in spring. 6-8"

Artemisia a. Powis Castle (1 qt) Zone 4

The soft and freshly aromatic silvery foliage forms an attractive clump to 18" tall x 3' wide, which rarely flowers. It makes a stunning ground cover when mass planted and is insanely drought tolerant once established. 18-26"

Guara Karalee Petite Pink (1 qt) Zone 5

Small coral pink flowers form at the end of each thin stem above medium green foliage. This plant has a long blooming season, blooms begin in early spring and continues into fall. 10-14"

Heuchera hybrids (1 qt) Zone 6

Heucheras are at home in woodlands and rock gardens to containers, borders, and ground covers. Offering a dazzling array of foliage color, texture and shapes, Heuchera will make a statement in your garden. These perennials feature dainty flowers held aloft on airy stems in May through July.

H. x Kira Evergreen Forest

Silver in colored foliage, with distinctive dark green veining and pink flowers. 8-10"

H. x Kira Green Tea

Petite trailing succulent, grows 2" tall with trailing stems to 12". Colorful, heart shaped foliage in shades of rose, pink, cream and green.

Echeveria (1 qt)

Narrow rosette, green foliage with burgundy margins. 10-12"

- ☀ **S. r. Blue Spruce**
A drought tolerant ground cover with small, succulent blue leaves reminiscent of the needles of a blue Spruce. Yellow flowers accent containers, rock and alpine gardens.

S. x SunSparkler Lime Zinger

☀ Lime green foliage with a crisp, contrasting red edge. Hot pink flower heads last for weeks through late summer into fall, 2" tall with a 24" spread.

☀ **Senecio serpens (Blue Chalk Sticks)** (1 qt)

A small succulent that hugs the ground, branching from the base and rooting along the stems. The prostrate stems hold short powdery blue-green finger-like fleshy leaves. Small white flowers bloom in summer. 10-12"

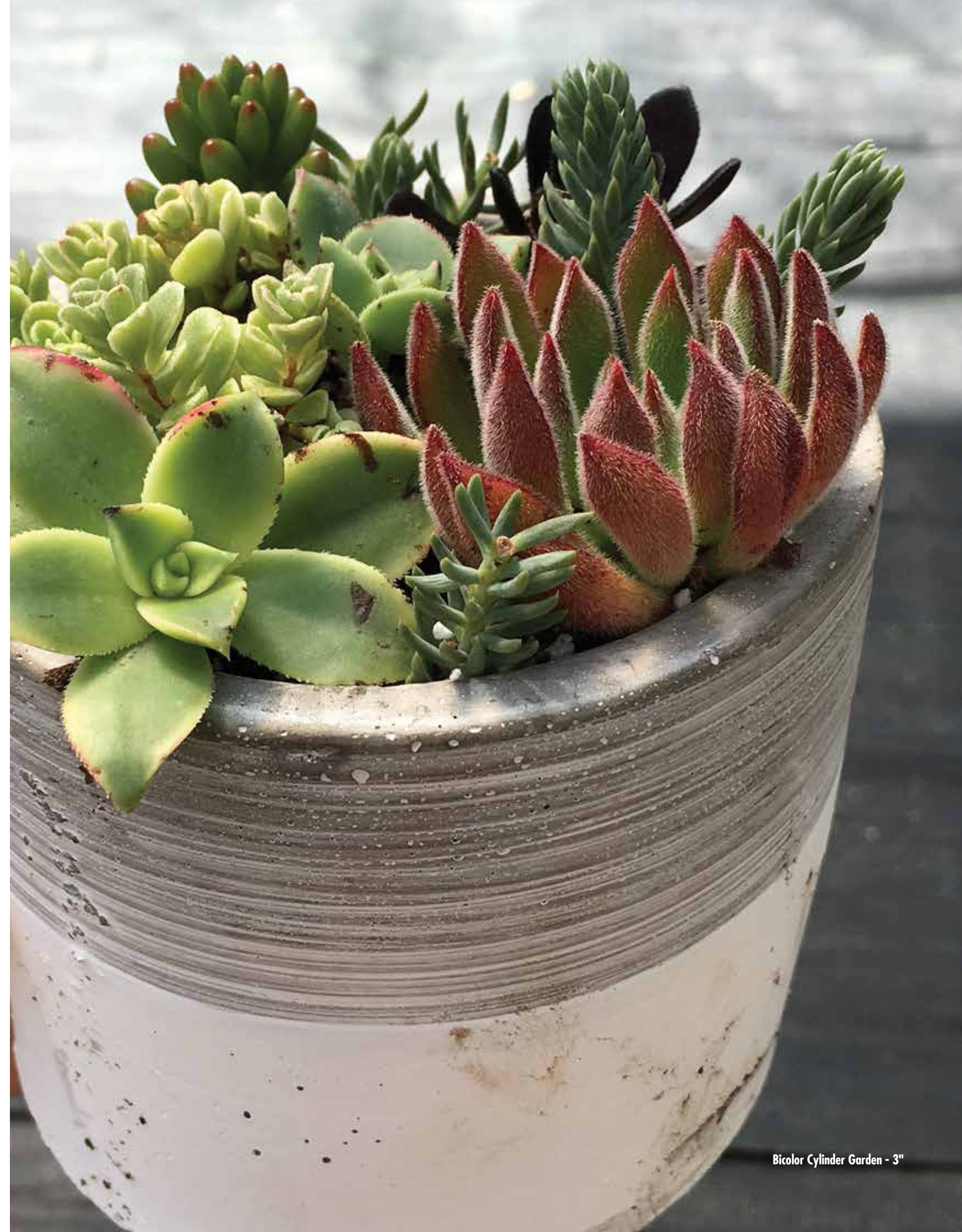
