

4594 Chrysophyllum viridifolium, fluted milkwood - seeds

Chrysophyllum viridifolium, commonly known as fluted milkwood, is a large evergreen milkwood tree that occurs in East African coastal forests and in some inland forests of the tropics and subtropics. The trunk may be fluted at the base, and the greyish bark is fairly smooth and mottled. The white flowers are borne in axillary clusters. The edible fruit are almost round and slightly ribbed, and ripen to a yellow color.
