

Peperomia

Peperomia blanda var. floribunda Pep-E-rome-E-ah BLAN-dah Category: Ground cover/Low-growing

Under 1m

Height: 0.5 metres

Spread: 0.3 metres









Full shade



Moderate water



Well-drained, moist soils



Indoor plant



Hanging baskets

A delightful spreading herb with succulent and slightly hairy leaves. Tiny white flowers on spikes up to 12cm long. The flowers are barely visible and look more like plain green spikes on the end of the branches. Very hardy indoor plant.

Likes to grow on mossy rocks, tree trunks, and other shady spots. Great spreading and hardy ground cover. HOT TIP: The name "floribunda" implies that it gets lots of flowers, but don't get excited – the long, bumpy "sticks" on the end of the branches are the flowers.
